SECTION 3 WNAC APPOINTMENTS

Whenever WNAC Representative vacancies occur, the WNAC Board will ask the affected membership group to appoint a person to fill the vacancy. Any person 18 years of age and over, who is eligible to represent one of the categories, or represents a group within an eligible category and subscribes to the goals and aims of the WNAC may be considered for WNAC Representative membership. When a category / association puts forward a representative, that representative will be accepted as a member. In the event no representative is put forward by a category or association, the WNAC Board will appoint new WNAC Representative members by a simple majority vote.
